A blessed Holy Thursday to you all,

As we prepare for a most unusual celebration of the Triduum and Easter, I would like to bring a couple of items to your attention:

- 1. Parishes who wish can encourage their parishioners to carefully place a lighted candle in their windows of their homes on Holy Saturday night. This is meant to be a sign of the Light of Christ which dispels all darkness and a gesture of our solidarity on this Holy Night.
- 2. Parishes whose churches have bells are asked to ring their bells for five minutes beginning at **Noon** on Easter Sunday. This is meant to be an expression of our Easter Joy. If you wish you may choose to ring bells in your home as well at noon Easter Sunday.

These are very difficult days for our parishioners and for us. Let us continue to pray for one another.
